Biography

Dr. John Sotos is a cardiologist with professional interests in sleep medicine diagnostics, unusual manifestations of disease, and in the medical histories of American Presidents. In 2003 he established that President William Howard Taft was afflicted with severe sleep apnea.

Dr. Sotos is a medical consultant to the top-rated television series House, MD. All of his medical training was at Johns Hopkins, where he earned his M.D. degree, performed an internship and residency in medicine, and completed fellowships in cardiology and on the Cardiomyopathy Service. He has bachelor's degrees in chemistry and in mathematics from Dartmouth College, and a master's degree in computer science (artificial intelligence) from Stanford University. Dr. Sotos is currently CEO of Apneos Corporation, and a Colonel and a Chief Flight Surgeon in the California Air National Guard.
